I, **Siegfried Blunk** (ស៊ីកហ្វ្រីដ ប្លង់), Co-Investigating Judge of the Extraordinary Chambers in the Courts of Cambodia (the "ECCC");

**Noting** the Law on the Establishment of the Extraordinary Chambers in the Courts of Cambodia, dated 27 October 2004 (the "ECCC Law");

**Noting** Rule 21, 55, 71 of the ECCC Internal Rules (Rev.7) (the "Rules");

**Noting** the judicial investigation being conducted pursuant to the Co-Prosecutors' Third Introductory Submission;

**Noting** the delegation of power made by Judge YOU Bunleng dated 17<sup>th</sup> June 2011;

**Noting** that on 15 June 2011, the International Co-Prosecutor ("the ICP") filed the Supplementary Submission which is intended to supplement and clarify the factual matters to be investigated by the Co-Investigating Judges in Case File 004 and to add new crime sites in Sector 1 of the Northwest Zone and crimes committed against the Khmer Krom in the Southwest and Northwest Zones;

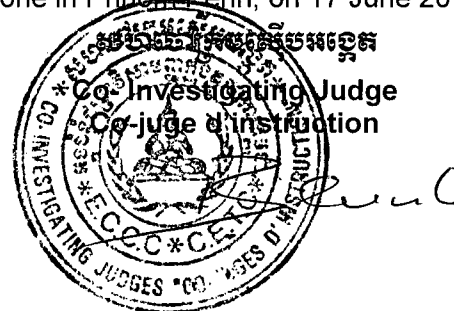
**Noting** that the Request has been filed in the name of the ICP alone and copied to the National Co-Prosecutor and that the ICP informed that the Supplementary Submission is submitted subject to Rule 71 (3) and the disagreement of the Supplementary Submission had been recorded and placed in the register kept by the greffier of the Co-Prosecutors in compliance with Rule 71 (1)<sup>1</sup>;

**Considering** that as the Co-Investigating Judges during the judicial investigations have the obligation in accordance with Rule 21 (1) to safeguard the legal certainty and transparency of the proceeding, they are obligated to ascertain when the disagreement between the National Co-Prosecutor and the ICP pursuant to Rule 71 (1) has been recorded.

**FOR THESE REASONS, THE CO-INVESTIGATING JUDGES HEREBY:**

**ORDER** the Co-Prosecutors to disclose within two working days when the disagreement pursuant to Rule 71 (1) has been recorded.
