INTRODUCTORY SUBMISSION
EXPLANATORY NOTE

The Introductory Submission, Case File and Other Evidentiary Material comprises two distinct elements of identical information – in hardcopy and electronic copy format.

The hardcopy format of the Introductory Submission comprises (a) the Introductory Submission with attached Annexes A, B, C and D and Schedules 1-105; (b) the Case File comprising the Witness Complaints and the Witness Interviews; and (c) Other Evidentiary Material.

a) The Introductory Submission with annexes and schedules consists of the following material:

i. The Introductory Submission, which is the primary document containing the crimes which the Co-Prosecutors have reason to believe were committed and naming the persons the Co-Prosecutors have reason to believe committed these crimes.

ii. Annex A is a list of all acronyms used in the Introductory Submission. Annex B is a list of witnesses, categorized according to issues they have knowledge of and can testify to. Annex C is the Document Index, a consolidated table of all the documents that have been referred to in the Introductory Submission. It is in A3 format to allow easy viewing and accessibility, and is sorted by Document Type. Each document is assigned a unique IS Document Number to assist identification. The Index contains the IS Document Number; the Document Type; the Documentation Centre of Cambodia Number; the date, the author, and the full name of the document; a brief description of the contents of each document and what the document assists in proving; the Electronic Reference Number (ERN); and the relevant Khmer and English page numbers. Annex D consists of this Explanatory Note with the CaseMap ‘Object – Persons’ (**Attachment A**) ‘Objects – Places’ (**Attachment B**), ‘Objects – Organisations (**Attachment C**)’ and records in hardcopy format attached. Only those “Persons” that are not in the witness lists are included in these records to avoid duplicity.

- iii. Schedules 1-105 comprise excerpts from witness statements relative to the Crime Base section of the Introductory Submission.
- b) The Case File is the document containing Witness Complaints and Witness Interviews. The former have been received and considered by the Co-Prosecutors, while the latter represent the testimonies of the people who have knowledge of the alleged crimes. 7 complaints and 12 interviews have been included with 1 written record of analysis by Craig Etcheson, Investigator in the OCP. This last document has not been included in Casemap due to its completion shortly prior to filing.
- c) Other Evidentiary Material comprises 123 binders accompanying the Introductory Submission. It is sorted into 21 Document Types and incorporated in alternating blue and red colored binders. There is a numerical sub-index on the initial page of each Document Type detailing the contents of that Document Type.

The electronic format of the Introductory Submission contains CaseMap, a document management system containing all the evidence used in support of the Introductory Submission. CaseMap does not include any facts or issues, but contains documents, people, organizations and places. The Documents field in CaseMap and the Document Index (Annex C) are identical. The other categories are included because they are relevant to the documents in the Document field. However this extra material has been included in this Annex. CaseMap fulfills three tasks simultaneously:

- a. All evidence is referenced with multiple fields including document number, author, full name, description, and which issues or suspects evidence is related to. This facilitates evidence search considerably while also allowing organisation in multiple ways.
- b. Through issue linkages, Casemap allows users to see how evidence is interrelated from a juridical or factual point of view, whether through the relevant legal issue or with regard to a particular suspect.
- c. CaseMap allows documents to be stored electronically and, through the various reference field, to be organized in such a way that that allows them to be easily accessible. Often, entries will have multiple documents, including translations.
