- Pursuant to a Forwarding Order received on 11 August 2008 from the Co-Investigating Judges to clarify the scope of the judicial investigation requested in the Co-Prosecutors Introductory Submission dated 18 July 2007 (D3) and Supplementary Submission (D83) dated 26th March 2008 the following response is provided.
- 2.
