SUBJECT: Progress of Case 004/2, Ao An.

I write to you because I am concerned that we have filed three pleadings in English and Khmer in relation to Case 004/2, Ao An, and none of them have been notified to the Parties. The filings are:

1. International Co-Prosecutor's Request for Extension of Rule 80 Deadline and a Trial Management Meeting, 26 December 2019;
2. International Co-Prosecutor's Response to Ao An's Request Regarding Seizure of Case 004/2, 6 January 2020.
3. International Co-Prosecutor's Rule 80 Witness and Expert List Submission with Confidential Annex A, 13 January 2020.

I caused the filings to be taken in hard copy to CMS for filing on 26 December 2019, 6 January 2020 and 13 January 2020. They were provided to CMS in hard copy as CMS has not yet created an electronic filing option. CMS accepted the filings.

I sent courtesy copies of all three filings to the TC, Defence Counsel for Ao An and to Civil Parties on 27 December 2019, 6 January 2020 and 13 January 2020. In addition, it is my understanding that all three hard copy pleadings have been provided to the TC Greffier.

It is also my understanding that CMS is awaiting approval from the TC, via the TC Greffier, before it can assign a case number, create an electronic option and notify the filings, and that, to date, CMS has not received this approval.

Could you please consider and implement whatever steps, if any, Administration can take to move the process forward administratively and/or to try to resolve the delay.
