Telegramme 43, Dated 23 April 1977

With Respect to Beloved Brother Reuan

1. We have now handed over the problem of Li to Uncle Lav. As for the other two, he says wait until the district comes to get them in order to be clear.

2. He gave us some reports about the responses of the three enemies who were previously arrested, to wit,

A. They have 31 of their number on duty to conduct activities in Sector 107.

B. There are six of their number in Khlong village, 36 in the cooperatives, eight in the districts, and then there are 23 organizers who come directly from Yuonland to be in charge of everything.

C. Their duties are to grasp the army, offices and concentrations of people.

D. Their plan schedules the attack on us for this April or May, 1977.

3. The situation in the highlands is that Uncle Lav has taken arrest measure after measure, but they're still not all gone. His wish is that we cooperate with him closely and he wants us to help him with surveillance and further cooperation.

4. The situation in Sector 107 is severely complicated, to wit:

A. The people have no rice or tubers.

B. There is powerful enemy harassment.

C. After the 17 April celebrations, approximately 50 or 60 of the Sector's mainline forces deserted back to the cooperatives.

D. The situation over in 81 is that Battalion 813 saw two Yuon walking, but we were not able to open fire on them quickly enough. ...
