Accordingly, subject to any later decision of the Co-Investigating Judges (see paragraph 2), you are now considered to be a Civil Party in the judicial investigation relating to that case.

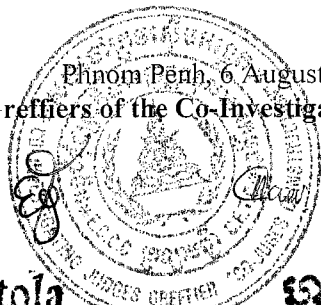
It should be recalled that the Co-Investigating Judges may, at any time during the judicial investigation, make a formal decision with respect to the admissibility of your application, and reject it if they consider that you are not a victim or that the criteria set out in the Internal Rules and in the Practice Direction on victim participation are not fulfilled. Such decision is open to appeal before the ECCC Pre-Trial Chamber.

You should also be aware that, through your participation as a Civil Party, you and your lawyer may have access to confidential information contained in the case file. Only the ECCC Judges can decide to make such information public. You are bound by the confidentiality of the judicial investigation not to disclose any information, except personal information that you have provided to the judges in your application.
