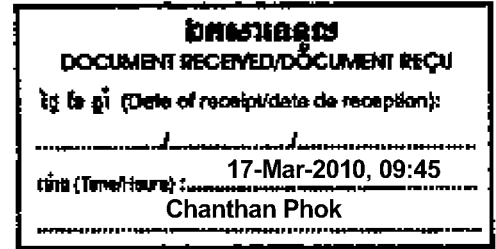

Dear beloved Com 870,



1. We reached the battlefield in the evening of 04 April 1978 at 6.30, and have received *Angkar's* letter.
2. As for the situation at Katum កាតុំ and Memut មេមត់ battlefields, the enemy at Boeng Mrông Leu បឹងម្រោងលើ and Boeng Mrông Kraom បឹងម្រោងក្រោម next to our border is still constantly pressuring.
3. At the battlefield west of Kampong Roka កំពង់រកា to Bânteay 27, Au ROUNG អូររូង, Svay Nhoar ស្វាយញ៉ាវ, the enemy also counter-attacked us hard east of Road 22 near Svay Nhoar, but they could not penetrate us.
4. At spearhead Prêk Choar ព្រែកក្នាំង, the enemy has a force of approximately two regiments. They have successively added to their forces; there are five tanks at Bêng បឹង along Road 7. Their infantry reached Sa-âm ស៊ាំ village since 12 noon on one front. On another front, they moved furtively three kilometers north of Road 7 to Chong Kăosou ចុងកៅស៊ូ, east of Sa-âm village.
5. Our forces have left Kampong Cham and have arrived in the area east of the tributary. They will come successively. Concerning the situation mentioned above, I would like to request *Angkar* to arrange to send the units of both Comrade Vĩn វីន and Comrade Nhâ ញ៉ា pre-equipped with weapons to urgently come to meet me at the tributary to join my force to surround and smash the enemy.
6. I would like to confirm to *Angkar* that Brother Phim ភីម has taken action by withdrawing one battalion of Sector 20 forces and some of the forces of Comrade Kĩm គីម to attack the enemy at Sa-âm. According to my evaluation, the enemy may strike out along Road 22 on 05 April 1978 because they have reached as far as Sa-âm spearhead. We do not yet have mastery over the Sa-âm battlefield.
