## REQUEST

- 1. On 8 May 2013 the Khieu Samphan Defence requested the Trial Chamber to hold a Trial Management Meeting "so as to hear the parties' views before fixing the schedule for the last remaining weeks of hearings in Case 002/001." On 16 May 2013 the Trial Chamber's Legal Officer, Matteo Crippa, notified the parties via email that the Trial Chamber intends to schedule a trial management meeting. The email stated "in light of the recent requests received by the Chamber and the current schedule of the trial proceedings, the Judges of the Trial Chamber authorized me to inform you that the Chamber will in due course schedule a hearing to discuss outstanding matters pertaining to the remainder of Trial 002/01. As per Chamber's previous practice, a tentative agenda will be circulated in advance to all parties."
- 2. The Co-Prosecutors welcome this opportunity to be heard on the outstanding matters to complete this trial. In order to assist the Trial Chamber to make this trial management meeting as efficient as possible, the Co-Prosecutors respectfully propose that, one week prior to this meeting, the Trial Chamber provide the parties with the following information:
  - a list of witnesses, experts and civil parties the Trial Chamber intends to call before the conclusion of evidentiary proceedings (other than those already scheduled up to and including 4 June 2013);
  - a list of any further document hearings the Trial Chamber intends to hold (in addition to the announced document presentation hearings on the role of Nuon Chea and the five Joint Criminal Enterprise policies);
  - c. a list of any further oral hearings on outstanding issues;
  - d. a timetable from 4 June 2013 until the end of the evidence hearings including any recesses planned; and
  - e. a timetable for the final oral arguments in this trial, including the time allocations to the parties for their oral submissions and responses.
- 3. It is further proposed that the parties be invited to make submissions on the Trial Chamber's final schedule after receiving the information referred to in paragraph 2, and at least three days

before the trial management meeting. Such submissions or observations should include lists of witnesses, experts and civil parties, as well as document and other hearings, that the parties request in addition to those notified by the Trial Chamber. Submissions should also be invited on the timetable and the length of oral closing arguments, as necessary.

4. It is respectfully submitted that this proposed exchange of substantive information between the Trial Chamber and the parties prior to the trial management meeting will significantly assist the Chamber in addressing in a timely manner all issues relevant to the conclusion of the evidentiary proceedings. It would allow the parties to fulfill their roles and obligations in this respect.
