

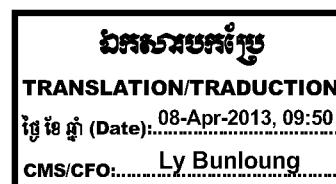

The Mission of the Royal Government of National Union of Cambodia to France announces that that the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of the GRUNC issued the following press release on 28 April 1975:

“Diplomatic and consular missions accredited to the Phnom Penh traitor regime shall not be entitled to claim any accepted customary and conventional diplomatic privileges and immunities from the GRUNC;

“During the five years of our war of national liberation, the GRUNC repeatedly stated that it shall not be bound, by reason of state succession, by the acts of the Phnom Penh traitor regime and that, as a result, it accepts no responsibility for any such acts.”

PRESS RELEASE FROM THE MINISTRY OF FOREIGN AFFAIRS OF THE ROYAL

The Ministry of Foreign Affairs of the GRUNK (Royal Government of National Union of Kampuchea) wishes to provide the following clarification so as to avoid any misunderstanding regarding the representation of the National United Front of Kampuchea (FUNK), the Royal Government of National Union of Kampuchea (GRUNK) and the people of Kampuchea at the international level:

The sole political and diplomatic representatives of the FUNK and of the GRUNK abroad shall be duly appointed or accredited members of the FUNK to friendly nations by Samdech Norodom Sihanouk, Head of State and President of the FUNK, and by the GRUNK, with Samdech Penn Nouth as Prime Minister and Mr Khieu Samphân as Deputy Prime Minister.

No other person – and much less those who served the traitor regime until the liberation of Phnom Penh by the FUNK – is entitled to speak on behalf of the FUNK, the GRUNK and the People of Kampuchea or to represent them ./.
