Direction to Civil Party Lead Co-Lawvers to Provide Additional

Information concerning Requested Protective Measures

- 1. On 8 April 2014, the Trial Chamber ordered the Parties to file updated lists of witnesses, Civil Parties and experts proposed for Case 002/02 (E305) ("Preparation Order"). Where protective measures were sought, the Chamber ordered the Parties to identify the relevant individuals and briefly indicate the requested measures on a separate and 'strictly confidential' list (E305, para. 5).
- 2. On 9 May 2014, the Civil Party Lead Co-Lawyers filed their lists of witnesses, Civil Parties and experts proposed for Case 002/02 (E305/7). The Lead Co-Lawyers identified one individual for whom they sought protective measures in a separate and 'strictly confidential' annex (E305/7.1.2). However, they failed to either indicate the protective measures sought or give a reason for such omission. While this constitutes a failure to comply with the Preparation Order, the Chamber has a duty to ensure that trials are conducted with full respect for the protection of victims (ECCC Law, Art. 33 (new); see also ECCC Agreement, Art. 23). The Chamber therefore directs the Lead Co-Lawyers to indicate, on a 'strictly confidential' basis, the protective measures sought no later than 20 June 2014.
- 3. The Chamber will seek further submissions concerning these protective measures requests in due course (E305, para. 6).
