I. DISCLOSURE

1. The Co-Prosecutors hereby disclose two documents (the “Documents”) relevant to Case 002. The Documents both originate from the Documentation Center of Cambodia (“DC-Cam”).
2. The Trial Chamber has stated that the obligation to disclose relevant material, whether inculpatory or exculpatory, is an obligation that is owed to the Trial Chamber, as well as the Accused, as it is “in the interests of ascertaining the truth that the Trial Chamber has access to these documents.”¹ Moreover, this Chamber has previously held that “Internal Rule 53(4) imposes a continuing obligation on the Co-Prosecutors to disclose to the Trial Chamber any material in its possession that may suggest the innocence or mitigate the guilt of the Accused or affect the reliability of the evidence.”²
3. The first document is a DC-Cam report entitled “Field Trip’s Report in Preah Netr Preah District, Banteay Meanchey Province”³ and dated 14-19 June 2011. It summarizes the evidence of 66 individuals interviewed by DC-Cam in the course of an investigative trip to Preah Net Preah District. Many of the interviewees discussed their experiences at the Trapeang Thma Dam worksite. The report is attached as Annex A.
4. The second document is an interview from that investigative trip with an individual named Mom Koeng.⁴ Mom Koeng discusses the assignment of workers to the Trapeang Thma Dam project, though she herself was not selected and did not work on the project. The interview is attached as Annex B.
