## I. REQUEST

1. The Office of the Co-Prosecutors (“Co-Prosecutors”) files this request to rely on additional authorities in relation to addressing the five questions posed by the Supreme Court Chamber (“Supreme Court”) at the rescheduled appeal hearings, and attaches those authorities as annexes hereto.
2. On 5 November 2015, the Supreme Court posed five questions for the Parties to address at the appeal hearings. The Supreme Court further ordered the parties to file, no later than 13 November 2015, any authorities they intended to rely on during the appeal hearings then scheduled to commence four days later on 17 November 2015.<sup>1</sup>
3. Given the additional time since the postponement of the appeal hearings, the Co-Prosecutors have further researched the complex issues raised by the Supreme Court in the five questions and discovered a few additional authorities they believe are pertinent and which may assist the Chamber in its consideration of these questions. The Co-Prosecutors submit that it is in the interests of justice for these materials to be available to all parties and the Chamber before the hearings and therefore request permission to revise the list previously submitted to include these authorities.
