
Dear Parties,

Further to the emails below received from the Office of the Co-Prosecutors and the NUON Chea Defence, respectively, the Trial Chamber clarifies that Parties are required to submit formal Rule 87(4) requests with respect to prior witness statements. Such requests shall identify the specific documents and the fact that their admission is sought as prior statements of an individual testifying in Case 002/02. No further reasoning is required.

The Chamber considers that Duch's prior statements before the Military Courts fall within the scope of this procedure and directs the NUON Chea Defence to file a brief, written R 87(4) request accordingly.

Dear Ken,

Further to Bill Smith's email, the Co-Lawyers for Nuon Chea (the "Defence") have asked me to write you regarding Duch's statements before the military court in 1999.

It has come to the Defence's attention during its preparation for its cross-examination of Duch that the majority of Duch's statements before the military court apparently do not yet have E3 numbers. These documents are part of the D288/6.52/ $^*$  series, and the ones without E3 numbers appear to be the documents with numbers ending 4.6, 4.7, 4.11, 4.17, 4.23, 4.27, 4.30, 4.31, 4.32, 4.40, 4.44, and 4.45.

In the event that the Chamber determines that parties are no longer required to submit Rule 87(4) applications in respect of prior statements that are "on the case file" (i.e. available on Zylab) but do not have E3 numbers, the Defence seeks the Chamber's clarification whether this would also apply to such statements as well; that is, prior statements that are available on Zylab but not gathered in the course of ECCC proceedings.

If the Chamber determines that Rule 87(4) requests are still required for statements of this kind, then the Defence advises the Chamber that, at the earliest opportunity, it intends to make an oral request for the admission of all of Duch's statements before the military court which are available on Zylab but do not yet have an E3 number. In light of the current hearing schedule, the Defence proposes to make these oral submissions at the outset of the hearing on Thursday, 2 June 2016, prior to the appearance of the witness.

The Defence thanks the Chamber in advance for its consideration and response.





Dear Doreen, dear Parties,

Further to the email below from the NUON Chea Defence, the Trial Chamber recalls its practice to admit into evidence all prior statements of witnesses who testify before it, pursuant to Internal Rule 87(3) and (4) (E319/36/2, para. 15; E363/3, para. 25). It is in the interests of ascertaining the truth that the Chamber and parties have access to all of the statements of witnesses and Civil Parties who will be heard in Case 002/02. Further, these documents should be put before the Chamber to permit a complete assessment of their testimony. Therefore, the Chamber will proprio motu admit document E319/42.3.3 and its annexes E319/42.3.3.1, E319/42.3.3.2 and E319/42.3.3.3.

The Chamber also notes that Document E319/42.3.3 was erroneously assigned document number E3/9836 (see E1/412). The Chamber will now retain this document number, while it will assign document numbers E3/9836a, E3/9836b and E3/9836c to its annexes, respectively.

An official memorandum will be issued in due course. Accordingly, there will be no need to hear oral submissions from the parties on this matter.

Concerning the request to obtain color copies of E319/42.3.3.1, E319/42.3.3.2 and E319/42.3.3.3, the Chamber will request these from the Office of the Co-Investigating Judges and place these in the Case File in lieu of the current versions as soon as available.

Dear Ken, dear parties,

The Co-Lawyers for Nuon Chea (the "Defence") have instructed me to advise the Chamber that, at the next available opportunity, they intend to make a brief oral submission pursuant to Internal Rule 87(4) seeking the admission into evidence of a WRI of Kaing Guek Eav alias Duch, E319/42.3.3 (in Khmer and English), together with its three attachments E319/42.3.3.1,

E319/42.3.3.2, and E319/42.3.3.3 (currently only in Khmer). These documents were disclosed from Case 004 and made available to the Defence on 16 March 2016. The Defence intends to use these documents during its cross-examination of Duch.

The Defence notes that in the WRI E319/42.3.3, it appears that the OCIJ showed Duch colour versions of the attachments E319/42.3.3.1, E319/42.3.3.2, and E319/42.3.3.3. However, the versions available to the Defence are only in black and white. Accordingly, the Defence also intends to request, pursuant to Internal Rule 93, that the Chamber request the OCIJ to provide the parties also with the colour versions of the three attachments.

Noting the upcoming hearing schedule, the Defence proposes to make these submissions at the outset of the hearing on Thursday, 2 June 2016, or otherwise at a time that the Chamber deems most convenient.
