- 16 The witness who is to testify today -- that is, 2-TCW-894, has 17 taken an oath -- rather, took an oath yesterday before the Iron 18 Club Statue. The witness has Mr. Moeurn Sovann as her duty 19 counsel, and they are both ready to be called by the Chamber.

- 21 MR. PRESIDENT:

Thank you. The Chamber now decides on the request by Nuon Chea. The Chamber has received a waiver from Nuon Chea, dated 14 January 2016, which states that, due to his health, headache, back pain, he cannot sit or concentrate for long. And in order to

1	effectively participate in future hearings, he requests to waive
2	his rights to be present at the 14 January 2016 hearing.
3	Having seen the medical report of Nuon Chea by the duty doctor
4	for the Accused at ECCC, dated 14 January 2016, which notes that
5	Nuon Chea today has chronic back pain when he sits for long and
6	recommends that the Chamber grant him his request so that he can
7	follow the proceedings remotely from the holding cell downstairs.
8	Based on the above information and pursuant to Rule 81.5 of the
9	ECCC Internal Rules, the Chamber grants Nuon Chea his request to
10	follow today's proceedings remotely from the holding cell
11	downstairs via audio-visual means.
12	The Chamber instructs the AV Unit personnel to link the
13	proceedings to the room downstairs so that Nuon Chea can follow.
14	This applies to the whole day.

16	And before we commence hearing testimony of Witness 2-TCW-894,
17	the Chamber would like to inform the Parties the following.
18	The Trial Chamber has received additional submissions concerning
19	the in camera hearings of two witnesses from the Co-Prosecutors,
20	as well as the last communication from the International
21	Co-Investigating Judge.
22	The Trial Chamber and Parties received a courtesy copy of the OCP
23	request calling for reasons provided by the International
24	Co-Investigating Judge to hear testimonies of 2-TCW-894 and 938
25	in closed session. The OCP further asked the Trial Chamber to

2	Prosecution, the Trial Chamber heard oral submissions on the
3	matter this morning. The Trial Chamber has considered the
4	Parties' submissions. Nothing it has heard alters its decision to
5	proceed in closed sessions for these two witnesses.
6	While the Chamber wishes to ensure that the trial of Case $002/02$
7	remains publics, other factors must be considered. Full reasons
8	for this decision will be provided in writing in due course and
9	those reasons will, to the extent possible, be made public.
10	After the testimony of the two witnesses is completed in closed
11	session, the Trial Chamber will, in cooperation with the
12	International Investigating Judge, seek to release public
13	transcripts of their testimony redacted to the extent that the
14	International Investigating Judge requires.
