THE PRE-TRIAL CHAMBER of the Extraordinary Chambers in the Courts of Cambodia (“ECCC”) notes the “Co-Prosecutors’ Appeal Brief in Response to Co-Investigating Judges’ Order Regarding Request to Place on Case File Additional Evidentiary Material Which Assists in Proving the Charged Persons’ Knowledge of the Crimes,” filed by the Co-Prosecutors on 4 May 2010.

ORDER

1. The Pre-Trial Chamber hereby schedules the above mentioned appeal for hearing pursuant to Rule 77(3)(a) of the Internal Rules (Rev.5), which provides:

The President of the Chamber shall verify that the case file is up to date and set a hearing date.

2. The Pre Trial Chamber notes that the scheduling is conditional on the Chamber receiving notice from a respondent to the appeal as anticipated in the Direction dated 30 April 2010. The Pre-Trial Chamber shall proceed on the basis that submissions on appeal, filed pursuant to Internal Rule 75(3), shall be taken as read by the Chamber. Oral responses and replies will be taken at the hearing. If the Chamber receives no notice, in the time specified, the appeal will be determined on written submission only.

3. The Pre-Trial Chamber reminds the parties of the condition it has previously articulated:

Any party wishing to be heard as a respondent to a particular appeal must give notice of such intention to the Pre-Trial Chamber and the other parties no later than ten days from the date of the notification of the written submission in any appeal or within five business days from the notification of a matter being set down for hearing, whichever is the sooner.

4. The hearing will take place *in camera*.

THE PRE-TRIAL CHAMBER HEREBY SCHEDULES the above mentioned appeal for hearing on **26 of May 2010** commencing at **2:00pm** to allow oral responses and replies, if so required.
