## INTRODUCTION

- 1- Pursuant to the provisions of the Internal Rules, the Civil Party Co-Lawyers for Group 3 submit this Notice of Appeal against the Order on the admissibility of civil party applicants from current residents of KEP province, dated 25 August 2010, and notified to the parties on 26 August 2010.
- 2- In the said Order, some civil party applicants were declared admissible while others were declared inadmissible.
- 3- The appeal deals exclusively with those applicants who were declared inadmissible and concerns the following victims:
  - Chhay Eng 09-VU-1302 (D22/2709)
  - Eav Yih 07-VU-00344 (D22/0595)
  - Kao Chhorn 09-VU-01304 (D22/1595)
  - Hem Kang 09-VU-01303 (D22/0665)
  - Um Yich 09-VU-03434 (D22/3152)
  - Eang Uth 09-VU-01305 (D22/2710)
- 4- The appeal is in accordance with the provisions of Internal Rules 23 *bis* (2), 74(4)(b) and 77 *bis*.
- 5- The appeal briefs of the appealing parties will be filed with the Pre-Trial Chamber within the prescribed time limits.

## CONCLUSIONS

- 6- The Co-Lawyers for the Civil Parties request the Co-Investigating Judges:
- 7- To find their appeal admissible,
- 8- To hold a public hearing and to allow the filing of additional materials,
- 9- To annul the Order,
- 10- To find the civil party applications of Victims Chhay Eng, Eav Yih, Kao Chhorn, Hem Kang, Um Yich and Eang Uth admissible and with merit.
