Re: Case Nº 002/19-09-2007-ECCC/OCIJ (PTC75)

On behalf of the Pre-Trial Chamber I write in relation to Case File N° 002/19-09-2007-ECCC/OCIJ (PTC75). In this Case-File the Pre-Trial Chamber of the Extraordinary Chambers in the Courts of Cambodia ("ECCC") is seized of "leng Sary's Appeal against the [Co-Investigating Judges]' Closing Order (the "leng Sary Appeal"), filed on 25 October 2010.

On 13 January 2011, the Pre-Trial Chamber announced, in writing, its determination of the final disposition on the Appeal indicating that "the reasons for this decision shall follow in due course."


The Pre-Trial Chamber will soon finalize the English version of its fully reasoned decision on this Appeal. As the Appeal raises a number of legal issues of considerable complexity and of high importance for the Charged Person, the Cambodian people and the Khmer speaking legal community, the Pre-Trial Chamber determined that the rights of the parties would be most egregiously affected by failing to properly and thoroughly assess and address all the issues raised and by not providing its full reasoning in English and Khmer ²

Thanks to the continuous assistance of the Khmer Interpreters, all the issues raised in the Appeal have been extensively discussed and deliberated in the presence of the full Chamber.
