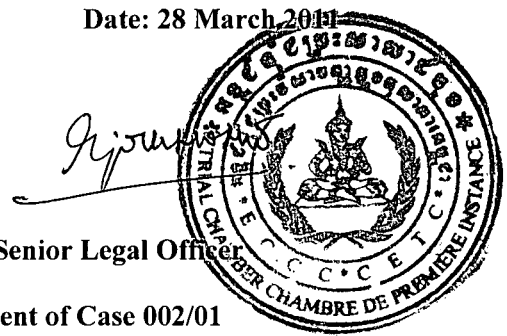

**SUBJECT:** Revised order of witnesses for current segment of Case 002/01



Further to its memorandum of 17 February 2012 (E172), the Chamber informs the parties that witnesses whose testimony is expected to focus on communication structures will now be heard at the end of the present trial segment (Administrative and communications structures, and some elements of the roles of the Accused). After concluding the hearing of KAING Guek Eav *alias Duch's* testimony, the Chamber will hear the following witnesses in the approximate order indicated below:

- Administrative structures (Centre)*

- Ministries (B-1, Ministry of Foreign Affairs)*

The hearing of the remaining witnesses listed in E172 will be scheduled at a later date, once their availability is confirmed. The parties are accordingly on notice that any of the witnesses listed in E172 may be heard before the Chamber, and that the above order may alter where effective trial management so requires. Where the Accused elect to testify, witnesses may also be heard during half-day sessions, where necessary.

As indicated previously, information concerning a number of individuals that the Co-Prosecutors have requested to be heard as experts will be provided shortly.
