- Having afforded the parties an opportunity to raise issues for discussion, the Chamber provides the following Agenda for the Trial Management Meeting, scheduled for 5-7 April 2011 (E9/5). This schedule is indicative only. In accordance with Internal Rule 79(7) of the Internal Rules, the meeting will be held in closed session.
- 2. Due to the largely technical and procedural nature of the agenda items, the Accused are not required to attend the meeting, and the presence of individual Civil Parties is not contemplated. The Co-Prosecutors and the Co-Lawyers for each Accused may be accompanied by a maximum of four supporting legal staff, unless leave is otherwise granted by the Chamber. The Civil Party Lead Co-lawyers may also be accompanied by a maximum of four Civil Party lawyers, provided that each Civil Party lawyer has a specific role to fulfil at the Trial Management Meeting to support the Civil Party Lead Co-lawyers, as envisaged by Internal Rule 12ter. Selected Sections or Units of the ECCC have been requested to remain on stand-by in relation to certain agenda items to provide any information as may be necessary.
