BIOGRAPHY OF MR IENG SARY

- Born on 1 January 1930 in Bari (Prey Veng), Cambodia.
- Studied at *Lycée Sisowath* in Phnom Penh, and then in France (*Ecole Normale Supérieure*).
- Attended the East-Berlin International Youth Festival in 1951.
- Lost his French scholarship due to involvement in political activities in 1953.
- Was president of the association of Khmer students in France (*Union Générale des Etudiants Khmers en France*) from 1953 to 1956.
- Taught at *Lycée Sisowath* in Phnom Penh in 1958.
- Was considered as a communist cadre in charge of matters relating to Khmer teachers. Close ties with the USSR embassy in Phnom Penh.
- Left Phnom Penh in July 1963 to join the “Khmer Rouge” underground movement.
- Was representative of the domestic resistance within the GRUNK in Peking in 1971 – 72 – 73.
- Was special advisor to the GRUNK in the liberated zone starting in 1973.
- Went on frequent visits to China and North Vietnam.
