Mr. MEAS Muth, through his Co-Lawyers (“the Defence”), pursuant to Rule 21 of the ECCC Internal Rules, hereby requests the Co-Investigating Judges to place all Defence submissions on the Case File without undue delay. This Request is made necessary because Co-Investigating Judge Harmon has instructed the OCIJ Greffier not to place Defence submissions on the Case File and has stated that “[i]n the future, pending the appeal decision on the conflict of interest, the OCIJ Greffiers will be instructed to reject any additional filings.”¹ The Pre-Trial Chamber has now decided on the conflict of interest appeal, and has recognized the engagement of the Co-Lawyers.² Therefore, there is no reason that all Defence submissions should not be placed on the Case File expeditiously.

WHEREFORE, for all of the reasons stated herein, the Defence respectfully requests the Co-Investigating Judges to place all Defence submissions on the Case File.
