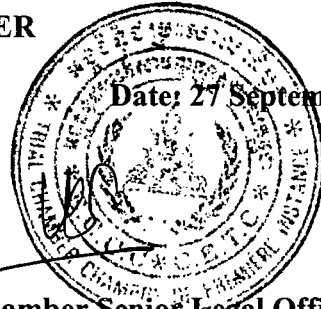

SUBJECT: Order Scheduling Cognitive Testing of the Accused

1. On 6 September 2016, the Trial Chamber issued a decision on each of the Accused's fitness to stand trial together with an order for the quarterly cognitive testing of each Accused (E389/5 for NUON Chea; E389/6 for KHIEU Samphan). In both decisions, the Chamber ordered the continuation of the Accused's quarterly cognitive testing using a test devised by experts and administered by medical professionals contracted to provide services to the ECCC Detention Unit ("Medical Unit") (E389/5, para. 13; E389/6, para. 13). The Chamber appointed Dr. CHAN Kin Ming and Dr. HUOT Lina as the experts who were to devise the cognitive test for the Accused and work with the Medical Unit to ensure their proper administration, with the first test being administered no later than 22 September 2016 (E389/5, disposition; E389/6, disposition).

2. The new Abbreviated Mental Test (AMT) devised by the experts was administered to each Accused on 9 September 2016 by two Medical Unit doctors, namely Prof. Chak Thida and Dr. Chhuor Channara. The Chamber considers it appropriate that future tests also be administered jointly by these two doctors. The Chamber directs WESU to coordinate and schedule the next three quarterly tests during the following timeframes:

- between 1 - 15 December 2016;
- between 1 - 15 March 2017; and
- between 1 - 15 June 2017

3. The Chamber further orders the Medical Unit to submit to the Trial Chamber the AMT results for each Accused as soon as possible after every respective test.
