STATEMENT OF HIS ROYAL HIGHNESS PRINCE NORODOM SIHANOUK, HEAD OF STATE OF THE KINGDOM OF CAMBODIA AND PRESIDENT OF THE CAMBODIA UNITED NATIONAL FRONT

In their statements before the United Nations, some delegations at the 29th session of the United Nations General Assembly – in particular those of Thailand, the Philippines, Japan, Indonesia, some of which countries are allies or well-known satellites of the imperialist USA and other the well-known accomplices of Us imperialism – attacked the Kingdom of Cambodia, a member of the United Nations since 1955, and its Government (G.R.U.N.C.), by pleading the wrong cause of the so-called "Khmer Republic".

According to these delegations:

- 1. GRUNC is merely a "government in exile" without a popular base or territory;
- 2. The war in Cambodia is a purely internal matter for the people of Cambodia;
- 3. The United Nations has no right to deal with the Cambodian question, although Cambodia is victim of the neo-colonialist aggression of the United States, another member of the United Nations;
- 4. The so-called "Khmer Republic" was formed on a "legal and constitutional" basis, with the approval and support of the Cambodian people.

On behalf of the Cambodian people, who have, since 1970, suffered the neo-colonialist aggression of the United States, and on behalf of the United National Front of Cambodia (F.U.N.C), the Royal Government of National Union of Cambodia (G.R.U.N.C) and the Popular National Armed Forces for the Liberation of Cambodia (F.A.P.L.N.C), I am registering a formal protest against the <u>falsehoods</u> propagated at the United Nations by <u>a handful of accomplices of United States imperialism</u> to the detriment of F.U.N.C, G.R.U.N.C and F.A.P.L.N.C. and against the <u>shameless misrepresentations of Cambodian realities and the historical events</u> that occurred in Cambodia (between March 1970 and the present time) by these same people <u>and</u> their respective governments, all dedicated to United States imperialism.
